



How to recover my password.

Enter your email account and click the “E-mail...” button.





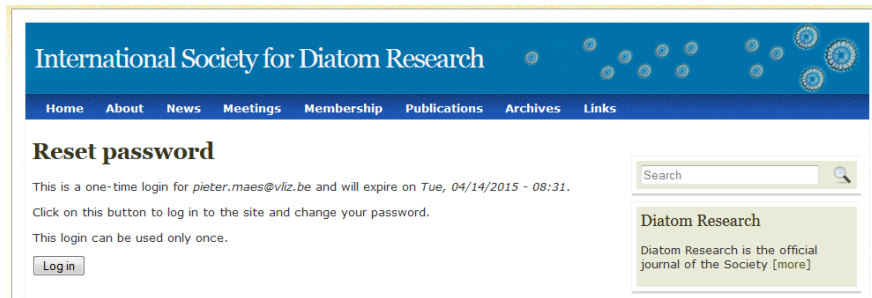
You should see the “Further instructions have been sent to your e-mail address” message appear.

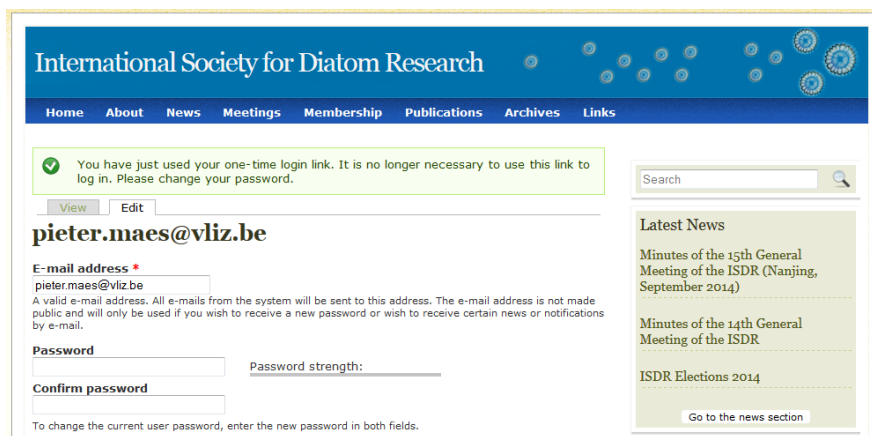
